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INTRODUCTION AND EXPLANATORY NOTES

The books, videotapes and DVDs listed in this bibliography were chosen because of their relevance to the study of the history and heritage of civil engineering. The bibliography is not exhaustive, and it does not cover all areas of civil engineering with equal emphasis, but it does provide a wealth of information of value to those who seek to learn about the role of civil engineers and civil engineering projects in the modern world. Although many of the books listed here are out of print, there are only a few that are so rare that a diligent searcher will not be able to locate a copy. (A good place to begin a search for books still in print but not available in local libraries is www.amazon.com. For books no longer in print, www.bibliofind.com provides access to the holdings of a national consortium of used book dealers.)

This bibliography does not contain engineering textbooks or magazine and journal articles, although there are many worthwhile articles on civil engineering history and heritage in periodicals such as ***Technology and Culture***, ***American Heritage of Invention and Technology***, ***Civil Engineering***, and ***Engineering News-Record***, to list only a few of the most commonly available. Other excellent sources of information on the history and heritage of civil engineering are the publications of state and local historical societies, corporate and institutional histories, Federal and State government documents and project reports, and publications such the District and Division histories published by the various offices of the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers. The proceedings of the American Society of Civil Engineers and the British Institution of Civil Engineers are excellent sources of contemporary reports on now historic projects.

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
